Rules:

1. Open to Washington County residents ONLY; open to horses of all breeds, registered and grade. 4-H/FFA Members from other counties may only compete if they are in a Washington County 4-H Club that they declare as their main club; or if they attend a school in Washington County. Youth are not allowed to compete in two county fair horse shows.
2. No entry fees will be charged.
3. Premium checks will be mailed to all exhibitors after the conclusion of the fair.
4. Horses will be judged by breed rules.
5. English Pleasure classes may be ridden hunt seat, saddle seat, dressage saddle, or English side saddle.
6. In Equitation classes, the rider is to be judged. Patterns will be posted the day of show; rail work only in 10 & Under Walk Trot Equitation classes.
7. If a performance class is not specified as Walk Trot, there will be a canter or lope called for.
8. Proper attire per breed standards is requested.
9. Juvenile age is 18 & under as of January 1, 2024. An exhibitor can turn 19 years old after January 1 of the current year and still compete as a juvenile that year.
10. Negative Coggins test required within past twelve months for all animals over 6 months old.
11. Stalls are available in the livestock barn for \$25.00, first come, first served. Exhibitors must leave two checks for \$25.00, to be made out to U of A Dept. of Animal Science; one check pays for the stall, the second check serves as a deposit to insure the stalls are cleaned before leaving. Pay for your stall in registration, BEFORE occupying a stall. Stalls must be cleaned before leaving show grounds. Upon inspection, one check will be returned to the exhibitor.
12. Equestrian of Tomorrow Award competitors must be a Bonafide 4H or FFA Member as defined in #2 of the General Rules to be eligible to participate in the Livestock Premium Sale.
13. Equestrian of Tomorrow designated classes may be entered by any age- appropriate juvenile. Membership in 4-H or FFA is not required to show in those classes, only to be eligible for the Livestock Premium Sale.
14. A Washington County Fair Code of Conduct must be signed by all exhibitors and parents.
15. Final decisions, relative to Horse Department will be made by the Horse Superintendents.

Horse Show Awards

1. Ribbons awarded for 1st through 6th place in all regular classes. In addition, premium money awarded as follows: 1st - \$12; 2nd - \$10; 3rd - \$8; 4th - \$6; 5th - \$4; 6th - \$2.
2. Championship classes will also be awarded Grand Champion and Reserve Champion rosettes and trophies.

3. Equestrian of Tomorrow Awards will be split by age groups –
 - a. Grand & Reserve Champion High Point Award in the 13 & Under group
 - b. Grand & Reserve Champion High Point Award in the 14 – 18 age group
 - c. **For current 4-H & FFA members only-** Points will accrue from seven eligible classes in each age group. In the event of a tie, the winner will be determined by the most first places in the eligible classes. If there is still a tie, the most second places will determine the winner. And thirdly, the highest showmanship placing will determine the winner if there is still a tie to be broken.
 - d. Champion Equestrian of Tomorrow winner in age group 5-13 and 14-18 will be displayed during the fair and in the Junior Livestock Premium Auction.
